From a modest beginning in 2022, this gathering has grown into one of the principal Indigenous-led energy-sector forums in Canada. With a keen focus on creating a welcoming environment to share knowledge and forge partnerships, this event will host more than 350 participants and will include a blend of workshops, keynotes, panels, presentations, and our signature Industry Tradeshow.

About the Conference

The 2025 Atlantic Indigenous-Led Energy Symposium will take place October 28-30th, 2025 in Moncton, New Brunswick. Terms of Sponsorship

- The deadline for sponsorship commitment is **August 31, 2025**.
- Certain sponsorship tiers are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Sponsors must provide all necessary promotional materials (logos, organization descriptions, etc.) by **August 31, 2025**, to ensure inclusion in event materials.
- Sponsors may decline the use of tradeshow space and/or speaking opportunities included in their sponsorship package. Once declined, these opportunities will be reassigned and cannot be reclaimed.
