Position: Oeliangitasoltigo Mental Wellness Team Lead

General description: Will provide leadership and coordinate all aspects of the project, including Mental Wellness Team outreach and service delivery, project oversight, reporting, communication, and governance with emphasis on culture and trauma informed care. Reports to OMWT Management Team.

Key responsibilities of the position

- Be the first point of contact and provide day-to-day coordination of all aspects of Oeliangitasoltigo Mental Wellness Team
- Culturally safe outreach and service delivery
- Coordinate with staff and project stakeholders to strengthen mental health and addiction services in each of the four communities.
- Coordinate approaches with the MWT, community health teams, RHA partners and others
- Communicate with all four communities and ensure they are kept up to date and included in project decision-making.
- Day to day supervision and scheduling of staff.
- Complete quarterly progress and yearly reports.
- Any other related duties assigned by the Management Committee.

Qualifications and requirements

- Minimum of an undergraduate degree or college-level diploma in management or human services counseling plus a minimum of 3 years or more of experience working with/in First Nation Communities.
- Strong organizational and effective interpersonal skills.
- Successful experience managing staff.
- Experience with project development and coordination.
- Knowledge of First Nations culture and traditional practices
- Knowledge of Trauma informed care approaches/supports
- Excellent communication and facilitation skills.
- Fluent in Microsoft Office applications.
- Must be available Monday to Friday and as required.
- Must have valid driver's license, ability to travel and access to own vehicle.
- Knowledge of the Migmag language
- Vulnerable Sector check
- Criminal Record Check
- Requires regular travel to each of the four communities
