Terms of Sponsorship

- The deadline for sponsorship commitment is ~~July 31, 2026~~ (extended).
- Certain sponsorship tiers are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Sponsors must provide all necessary promotional materials (logos, organization descriptions, etc.) by **August 14, 2026**, to ensure inclusion in event materials.
- Sponsors **may decline** the use of tradeshow space and/or speaking opportunities included in their sponsorship package. **Once declined, these opportunities will be reassigned and cannot be reclaimed.**
